**Fattman Secures \$125,000 for Webster**

*Fattman Secures Funding for Webster Lake Invasive Species Mitigation*

BOSTON- State Senator Ryan C. Fattman (R-Webster) secured \$125,000.00 in funding for Webster Lake's invasive species mitigation through the passage of Amendment 251, which the Senator offered during the State Senate FY16 budget debate.

"I am pleased by the passage of my amendment, which appropriates the necessary funds to address Webster Lake's invasive species problem," Fattman said. "The Lake generates recreational and economic activity, and millions of dollars have been invested by the town of Webster, Commonwealth of Massachusetts, and the Webster Lake Association to pursue the mitigation and maintenance of the Lake's invasive species problems."

Amendment 251 funds the restoration of the open water conditions at the mouth of Sucker Brook inlet cove, which would control non-native invasive species. The amendment also funds the regulation of non-native vegetation species and the mitigation of invasive water vegetation.
